

Died of wounds from shooting in Londonderry Sept 1972.

31 December 1973 24141230 Gdsm Alan Daughtery Age 23. Killed Belfast (Off Falls Road).

1st Battalion Iraq 2007

13 December 2007 25065292 Gdsm Stephen Ferguson Age 31. South East Iraq.

Major General Thomas Anthony Boam CB CBE died 20 November 2023. Aged 91. Joined Gds Depot following commissioning at RMA Sandhurst Sept 1950. Pltn Comd 2SG Aug 1952. Served both Bns. Adjt 2SG July 1957. Comd Off 2SG from Jan 1972. As a Major General he was posted to Washington & then Comd British Forces Hong Kong from June 1985 until Aug 1987. Retired Nov 1987 after 37 years service. Lived Sussex.

Lieutenant Colonel Michael Whiteley died 27 October 2023, Aged 84. Commissioned into the Regt 1960. Served both Battalions including as a Coy Comd 1SG Jan 1968 to Mar 1971. Regt Adjt Sept 1975 – Sept 1977. 2ic Gds Depot including attached to 1SG in Kenya Sept – Dec 1979. From Jan 1981 Comd Off 1UDR, DCOS London District then served HQNI. Lieutenant Colonel Commanding 1987 – 1987.

QM 1SG & QM 9 Royal Irish (UDR). Lived Kirkliston. Funeral Thursday 30 November 2023 1300hrs at Lorimer Chapel, Warriston Crematorium, Edinburgh and thereafter to Kirkliston Bowling Club.

The Scots Guards Malaya & Borneo Veterans

During the Regimental Gathering of 2013 hosted by the 1st Battalion at Catterick David Goodard in company with other former members of 1SG in Malaya suggested it would be a good idea to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Battalion leaving Pirbright to join 28th Commonwealth Brigade in Malacca, Malaysia.

In January 2014 it was decided that there was some mileage in the proposal and a committee was elected. David Goodard (Chairman), Sandy Low (Secretary), Captain Ronnie Paterson (Treasurer) & Brigadier Kim Ross immediately agreed to become President. A 50th Anniversary reunion took place in October 2014 at the Scots Guards Club and Sighthill Bowling Club over 2 nights. A SG Malaya & Borneo Veterans Association Standard was marched on parade by 4 pipers led by P/M Jimmy Banks. It was donated by Sandy Low and presented to Brigadier Ross.

Later David Goodard handed over as Chairman to John Miller.

It was decided to hold biannual reunions on alternate years to the Regimental Gatherings. In 2015 a CD "Goodbye Kalabakan" was recorded by the late Rab Rosie (a renown singer and accordin player) who was the Battalion Pioneer Sgt in Malaya.

Just prior to Covid a large reunion was held in Blackpool and a decision was made that due to the increasing age of members future reunions would be on a smaller scale with members usually keeping in touch via Facebook.

More recently it was decided to present the Malaya Borneo Veterans Standard to the Scots Guards Club where it will be displayed. The presentation of the Standard took place on Friday 10 November at the Fife dinner. Captain David Drummond Moray was Pltn Comd of 10 Platoon, Left Flank in Malaya and in a small ceremony he handed the Standard over to Major Iain Dalzel Job ~ President of the Scots Guards Club.

At the Fife Branch Dinner on 10 November, nearly 60 years on from the 1st Battalion serving in Malaya & Borneo there were 8 members of the SGMBVA: Colonel Johnny Clavering, Captain David Drummond Moray, Jimmy Banks, Dougie Duthie, Jimmy Farmer, Sandy Low, Tam Mackie & Ernie Melville.
