Further news & updates will be given out in due course as plans become firm.


A bed for the Weekend



COLIN FOSTER ~ A PIECE OF NEWS AND A REQUEST

In particular, I'm trying to find a **Directing Staff Edition of the April 1972 "Exercise Bocage"** tour organised by Headquarters London District - I came across what appears to be a participant's copy in the Archives in Caen this year, but I presume that there would have been a DS version with more details. I'm particularly interested as it covers the period I'm planning to write about & so the personal accounts would be really useful.

I wondered whether any Association Members had copies of either a Directing Staff edition of this 1972 tour – either their own copy or one that their father's received or they actually took part in the tour & would be prepared to share with me. It is interesting as, in addition to the Caumont battle, it also covers the latter battles for Estry & Chênedollé.
