ASSOCIATION NEWS

Highlands & Islands Branch

Drummer Paul Brown, killed in Northern Ireland on 2nd August 1990 aged 21 while serving wit the 2nd Battalion Scots Guards. The work to have Paul's name added to the Inverness Town War Memorial started when we were reminded that it was missing during the process of renovating the headstone of Paul Nicholls, who was killed in Northern Ireland in 1971 aged just 18 and who is buried in Halkirk Cemetery. Maxi MacDonald and Roddy Davidson visited Paul Brown's headstone in Kilvean Cemetery, Inverness and the Memorial to verify Maxi's memory of the omission.

On sharing this information around the Branch, Phil Johnstone whose brother Charles died whilst serving in the regiment in Canada in 1990, told us that his mother received a visit from the Legion and the Council to tell her that his name was to be added to the Memorial. On his next visit to the Legion, Phil asked if Paul's name should also be added, to be told that was not possible because Paul was not from Inverness. Phil shared this information amongst his fellow Scots Guardsmen, but no record remains of action taken to correct the omission.

Fast forward to May 2023 and Google quickly yielded a Herald article about Paul's family, which included that they had moved to Inverness in 1979 when Paul was 12 years old, and the family have remained in Inverness thereafter.

Armed with this information, we approached the Council and were provided with the process for having names added to memorials which required us to get (1) the family's support for the addition (2) the Legion's support and their advice as to the specific wording of the addition (3) get Community Council approval (4) get listed building approval.

These done, Paul's name was added to the Inverness War Memorial on 3rd October 2023.

The Highlands & Islands Branch held a ceremony on 28th October to celebrate the addition and give thanks for Paul's ultimate sacrifice. As well as 14 Scots Guardsmen, 9 Legion officials including their Padre, and the Lord Lieutenant, the ceremony was attended by 35 members of Paul's family.

Several members of the family expressed their appreciated for the work done to have Paul's name added and for the ceremony organised to celebrate it.
